



NEW TREE - WATERING GUIDELINES

Congratulations! You've contributed to a better earth just by planting a tree (or trees)!



NOW. You must make sure these babies get some water.

Please follow the guidelines below to ensure a well established tree!



HOW OFTEN?

- First 3 months: 2x per week.
- After 3 months: 1x per week until roots are established (up to 2 years).



HOW MUCH?

- 2-3 Gallons per watering



WHERE TO WATER?

- Apply directly over root ball
- Slowly pour to allow water to absorb into soil



! TIPS



Treegator bag example

- DO NOT bury the root flare, make sure it is exposed.
- Create tree "well" to reduce water run-off.
- Mulch around tree to maximize water uptake.
- Use a Treegator bag (find on Amazon) to provide a slow delivery of water over root ball.
